

CBAI National Tournament Directors Examination
Saturday and Sunday 29th and 30th May 2010

The aim of this 2 day intensive seminar is to give qualified Regional Tournament Directors the opportunity of being promoted to Assistant National TD's and eventually to National TD's. The content will be exam based - written, oral and practical where the candidates will be asked to give some 'live' simulated rulings at the table.

Participants are meant to be practicing Regional TD's in good standing with their regions and well versed in the Laws, Movements and Scoring. Applications are also welcome from keen club TD's who are seeking promotion to Regional TD status but these candidates should be aware that the course content is aimed at the higher standard National TD.

There will be some lecture and discussion time and it is hoped that all participants will learn enormously from the experience and become better directors at the end of the weekend regardless of their grade. As a reference manual 'The EBU White Book 2010' is the course outline for qualified National TD's. This is a comprehensive publication and is not meant to be learned verbatim but familiarity with its contents will be a distinct advantage.

Candidates can use law books, manuals, laptops etc to answer their questions just as they can in real life.
