### TRIAL & ENTRY UPDATES (July 2025)

There will be a three (3) x sixteen boards in each Round Robin and there will be three Round Robins in all.

#### SCHEDULE OF PLAY

As previously advised with 4 teams the Schedule of Matches will be a Round Robin Format.

The event will be played as a triple Round Robin of 3 x 16 board matches as follows:-

#### **Additional Information**

- 1. Information on grants for players representing Ireland at the European National Team Championships will be available from IBU Council in advance of the trials.
- 2. As previously advised Brown Sticker Convention & HUMS are allowed but these need to be submitted along with proposed defences **before 21**<sup>st</sup> **August 2025**.
- 3. All system cards need to be submitted before 5.00pm on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- 4. Additional Pairs :- If a team of four (4) wishes to add another pair prior to the Trials weekend, they can do so with the approval of the IC.
- 5. If a team wishes to change a team member prior to the start of the trials, they can do so with the approval of the IC.
- 6. The winning team will be selected as the Irish Women's Team to represent Ireland in Riga, Latvia, June  $26^{th}$  July  $5^{th}$  2026 (or amended dates if applicable) at the European National Women's Team Championships.

Please note if a team of four (4) win, a third pair who have played in the trials will be added to the team. The pair will be selected by the team in conjunction with the IC. The Team Captain will also be chosen by the team in conjunction with the IC along with a reserve pair.

#### 7. Substitutes

Substitutes will only be allowed on teams of four (4) and at the approval of the IC.

A substitute may be allowed in emergency circumstances only and for a limited number of boards. (max 32).

A substitution, which in the opinion of the IC Significantly affects the strength / weakness of a pair, is unlikely to be approved.

If a team is unable to provide a suitable substitute the Tournament Director will award the higher of the following to the non-offending team:-

- a) 12 VPs,
- b) The average VPs achieved by the non-offending team in the round robins.
- c) 20 minus the Average VPs scored by the offending team in the round robins.

Requests for Substitutes for what the IC considers to be convenience reasons will not be approved. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the TD is empowered to make emergency substitutions

Players cannot be changed during a stanza, unless there is a medical emergency, and only with the approval of the TD.

- 8. Each pair participating in the trials must have two copies of their system available to present to their opponents before a session of play begins. Cards must be in the correct format and templates in Word and Excel can be downloaded from <a href="http://www.eurobridge.org/regulations/systems/">http://www.eurobridge.org/regulations/systems/</a> and hard copies are available from the CBAI Office. Failure to fulfil this obligation or presentation of a card that in the opinion of the Tournament Director is insufficiently detailed will render pairs liable to an automatic penalty of <a href="https://www.eurobridge.org/regulations/systems/">1 VP</a> per match.
- 9. Slow play / late arrival will be penalised in accordance with regulations to be posted in the playing rooms. Screens will be used and the EBL regulations regarding use will apply.

- 10. If an appeal arises, the teams will be consulted by the reviewer for whatever additional information is required. The fee is €50 and if deemed without merit the fee along with up to 2 VPs will be deducted.
- 11. **Mobile phones** and other electronic devices capable of communication must be **SWITCHED OFF** in the playing area and be visible at the table at all times. Any player leaving the playing table prior to the completion of the stanza must leave their mobile phone and electronic devices at the table. A <u>2</u> <u>VP</u> penalty will be levied for a first offence and similarly for a second offence. Any further offence will be treated very severely by the TD. Should any player need to have their phone on for any emergency reason, please give it to the TD and explain the situation.

#### 12. Seating Rights

Round Robin 1:- The Home team will have seating rights

Round Robin 2:- The Away Team will have seating rights

Round Robin 3:- There will be blind Line-Ups

- 13. Ties: Ties will be broken based on the VP totals won between the teams in the Matches involving the tied teams. If there is still a tie, the tie will be broken based on the difference between the total number of imps won & lost by each team in the direct matches. If the tie still remains unbroken, the tie will be won by the team that had the highest imp difference in any one of its Matches against one of the other tied teams.
- 14. All pairs must play at least 50% of the boards i.e. at least 5 of the 9 Matches.
- 15. The International Committee is empowered to alter any of the arrangements or conditions including time, dates and venue, and to decide on all matters affecting these trials. Each player who enters is undertaking to represent Ireland if nominated and to abide fully with all the conditions of these trials.
