Inverted Ghestem

- •Bid of opps suit shows two highest unbid suits 5-5.
- •Bid of 2NT after opps opening shows two lowest unbid suits 5-5.
- •Bid of 3Clubs after 1C/H/S opening by opps shows highest and lowest unbid suits 5-5.
- •Bid of 3Diamonds after 1D opening by opps shows highest and lowest suits 5-5.

Multi 2 Diamonds

- •Either 6 H/S 5-10 points or a 21-22 2NT rebid.
- •2H relay & 2NT enquiry.
- •2NT after the 2H relay is 21-22NT may contain a 5CM.

Lucas 2's

- •Opening of 2H/S promises a 5CM & at least a 4 cm 5-11 points.
- •2NT is an enquiry 15+.
- •Answers to 2NT are 3C weak points and clubs as minor, 3D weak points and diamonds as minor, 3H strong & clubs, 3S is strong & diamonds as minor.
- •3C over 2 of the major is pass or correct.
